For 2014, we need a new copy of one form (the Medical Release Form) and need for you to look through your past enrollment for changes in information.

#### To Re-enroll for 2014:

- 1. Enclosed is a Medical Release Form please fill out this form and have it notarized.
- 2. When you return this form, please check to see that your contact information is correct.
- 3. Pick up a 4-H Code of Conduct if you do not already have one.
