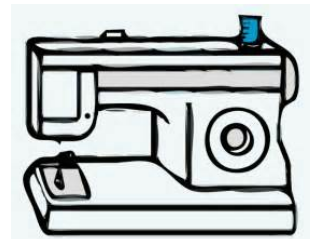

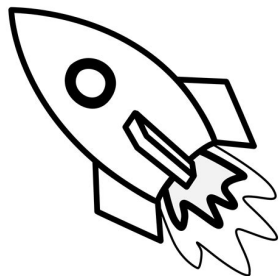

Butterflies, salamanders and weather stations – oh my. We have a hidden treasure in Macon County call the Coweeta Hydrologic Lab. They study our mountain water and weather systems. Let's go explore their station and learn all about the animals, amphibians and creeks of our mountains. We will hunt for salamanders, catch butterflies in their meadow and take a hike in the woods. Make sure to bring sturdy shoes.
